almost enough ...**

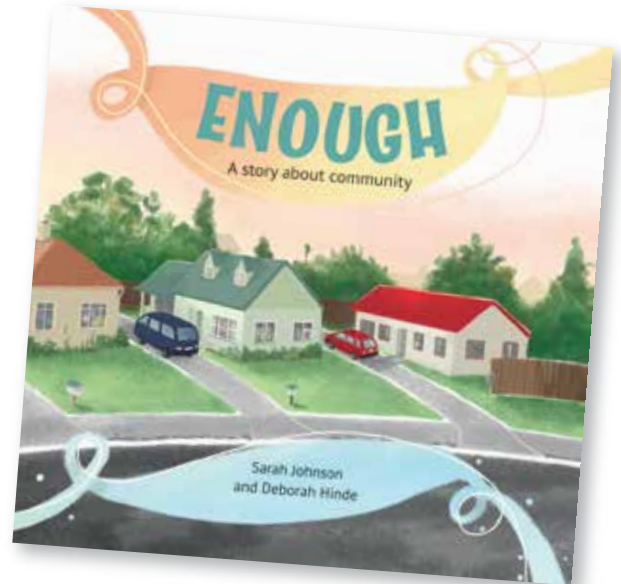
In Hana's street there is not enough.
